**MINUTES**

A workshop meeting of the Juniata County School District Board of Directors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Board President Danny R. Snyder.

In addition to Mr. Snyder, present were: Superintendent Keith Yarger, Mrs. Angela Varner, Mrs. Amy Wagner, Mrs. Christine Shadel, Mrs. Christine McLaughlin, Mr. Troy Woodward, Mr. Joseph Shearer, Business Manager Richard Meily, Director of Special Education Jill Condo, Mrs. Nancy Kramer, Mr. Clint Mitchell, Mrs. Christie Holderman, Mrs. Wendy Lauver and Mrs. Valerie Ricedorf. Mrs. Heather Kelly participated by telephone.

Mr. Woodward inquired about the remediation of problems with drip trays and flashing at East Juniata Elementary School. Project manager Jeff Harris said that he would have an answer for Mr. Woodward at the upcoming board meeting.

In response to a question from Mrs. Wagner about job descriptions for newly created positions, Dr. Yarger said that job descriptions are not approved by the board, but could and would be provided to the board.

Dr. Yarger reported that a construction meeting and tour of East Juniata High School revealed that the project is on schedule, with no problems moving forward, and that playground work had started at Juniata Elementary School. A tour of the facilities will be held for incoming students the first week of December.

Dr. Yarger also congratulated the East Juniata girls' soccer team on their post-season success, and Mrs. Wendy Varner reported that quarterfinal competition would be held November 10.

Mrs. Kramer reported that Fayette Elementary students had held a mock election.

East Juniata FFA member Ethan Jamison spoke about the extemporaneous speaking competition at the National FFA Convention, in which he placed among the top 16 competitors.

Elementary health and physical education teacher Robert Hart gave a presentation on the district's first-ever structured health and phys ed program. Mr. Hart thanked the board and

administration for implementing the program and said that he has received much positive feedback from students, parents and teachers.

Mr. Yarger reported that the fifth annual fall senior citizens' luncheon would be held November 15.

Mrs. Angela Varner announced that East Juniata musicians would be participating in Christmas in the Park in Richfield.


Dr. Yarger reviewed the November 15, 2018 meeting agenda.
